CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Toddler Time/Lunch: Is a Mommy & Me program that promotes socialization, an introduction to a classroom atmosphere, craft time, story time, snack time, singing, parachute, bubbles, etc. This is a super place for the children & Mom’s to make new friends. *Friday Toddler time is a 2.5 hour class which will include lunch.

Class Fees: \$8.00 per class/per child, which will pay for supplies & snacks.

Toddler Time: Is a Mommy & Me program that promotes socialization, an introduction to a classroom atmosphere, craft time, story time, snack time, singing, parachute, bubbles, etc. This is a super place for the children & Mom’s to make new friends.

Class Fees: \$5.00 per class/per child, which will pay for supplies & snacks.

Separation: This is a time when Mom’s leave their child(ren) in our kids room with volunteer sitters, down the hall. Our volunteers play, sing, dance with the children; keep them engaged.
(*You do not need to have a child(ren) to join or leave your child(ren) with the sitters to join. We also accept Dads too!).
-The sitters will bring the children to the Mom’s, for potty breaks, a boo-boo or just a hug.
-During this 1 hour session we Mom’s don’t just get an hour of time away from our child(ren) we get to socialize, discuss current issues, parenting & exchange ideas. Not only do we meet once a week, we also plan Mom’s nites, trips, game nites, etc.; we are more like a Mom’s Club.

*1 HOUR SESSIONS. Ages: no restrictions

Session Fee: \$10 per month, which will go toward gifts for the sitters, end of the year party & any other necessities that come up during the year.
