Low income, lack of urbanization and very high unemployment, are just a few of the challenges facing this area. Holy Trinity Church started a learning center to help the children to become better students, in hopes of creating a brighter future. They just completed the 4th year and have been successful thus far in their mission.

The Learning Center is offering tutoring services to the needy of Harlan County, KY. Education changes lives. The leaning center instills confidence and enables students to earn a diploma. 2/3 of those enrolled need financial assistance. The closest tutoring program of this kind is approximately 100 miles away, making access impossible for the poor.

Note: Currently, approximately 41% of the adult population of Harlan County has less than a High School diploma.

(*You do not need to have a child(ren) to join or leave your child(ren) with the sitters to join. We also accept Dads too!).

-The sitters will bring the children to the Mom’s, for potty breaks, a boo-boo or just a hug.

-During this 1 hour session we Mom’s don’t just get an hour of time away from our child(ren) we get to socialize, discuss current issues, parenting & exchange ideas. Not only do we meet once a week, we also plan Mom’s nites, trips, game nites, etc.; we are more like a Mom’s Club.

*1 HOUR SESSIONS. Ages: no restrictions

Session Fee: \$10 per month, which will go toward gifts for the sitters, end of the year party & any other necessities that come up during the year.
